Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop initially hiring four individuals. Product sales for their initial year of operation amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other parts. Through 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is among the leading global manufacturers within the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. All through the last 60 years, the business of material handling has grown into a really advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade currently continues to develop as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and various associated products. The company feels certain in their skill in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

Throughout the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to make, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was constructed in 1956, so as to house all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present head office. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total workers reached a hundred and eighty employees and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured worldwide due to lots of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to buying five firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global best in blades.
